Our facilities include therapy rooms, gymnasiums and two hydrotherapy pools with all the latest equipment to help you in your rehabilitation.


Our spacious rooms have an ensuite and many have views of the surrounding bushland. You will have access to New Caledonian television on the flat screen TV in your room.

We are also able to assist with toiletries and provision of clothing if required.











What happens when I leave Mt Wilga?

Prior to your return home we will liaise with you, your family and CAFAT regarding your equipment needs, any home modifications that may be required and any referrals for ongoing rehabilitation therapy.

For some patients, it may be appropriate for you to attend our Day Program for ongoing rehabilitation prior to your returning home, however, this will be dependent upon your individual situation and your access to alternative accommodation for that period.
